#### **GCA** Insurance

The next Insurance Renewal 2025/2026 (Form 2) has been posted on the GCA website and sent out to affiliated clubs in September. It asks you to declare the maximum number of members that you have had since last February and can be sent any time before the 19 February 2025 deadline. Your numbers are used to negotiate with the insurance brokers and Lloyds in London to secure the best deal.

# Open to the Public

Having a stall at an event organised by another organisation or running an open day at your meeting place, a shopping centre or local park etc are insured for \$20 million by your GCA Public Liability policy. Not only if a member of the public is hurt in an incident but also if they are affected by a plant or other product you sell. Only if more than 1,000 people are attending do you need to inform us. So spread the joy of gardening and get extra members.
